4.1. Adoption of an Urgency Ordinance Specifying Requirements for the Removal of Structural Debris and Hazard Trees from Private Property for Park and Thompson Fires

Motion approved by a 4-0-1 Vote (Supervisors Connelly, Ritter, Teeter and Chair Kimmelshue; Nays: None Absent: Supervisor Durfee) with changes made to prioritize roads that could be subject to damage due to weather; removing requirement for arborist certification after the complete removal of all hazard trees; and updating language to be consistent with previous changes made to Ordinance 32a, 34a and 38a, stating lien process will go through the Hearing Officer rather than the Board of Supervisors.
